



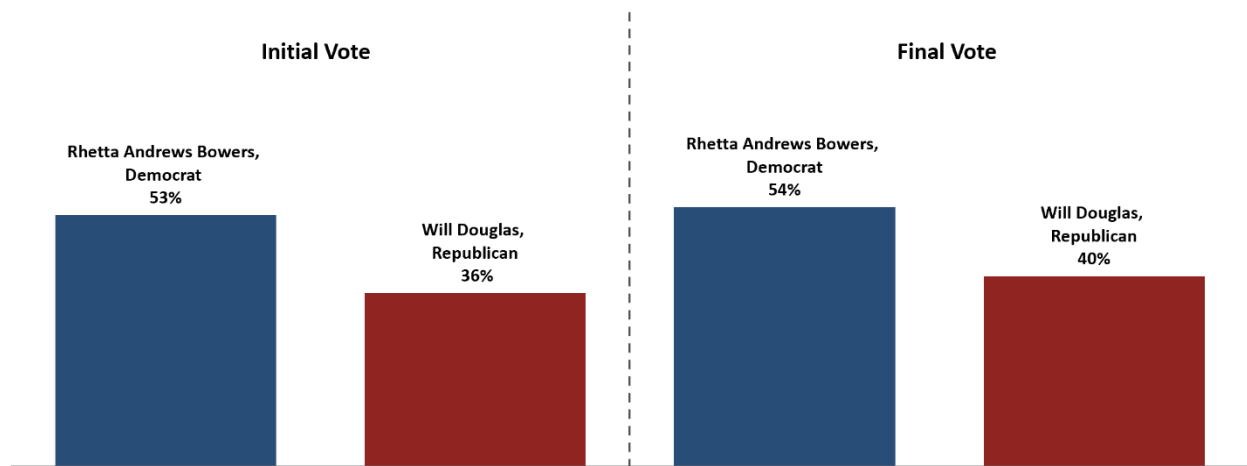

The following findings are from a poll conducted between July 29- August 2, 2020 among 405 randomly selected likely November 2020 general election voters in Texas House District 113. The results have an overall margin of error of ± 4.9 percentage points at the 95% confidence level. The survey included landlines and cell phones.

Democratic incumbent Rhetta Andrews Bowers holds a double-digit lead over Republican challenger Will Douglas.

Sizeable partisan shifts in House District 113 continue to favor Democrats. Hillary Clinton defeated Donald Trump by a narrow 2-point margin in 2016. Today, Joe Biden holds a commanding lead over Trump (Biden 57%, Trump 39%).

Bowers holds a 17-point lead over Douglas in an initial uninformed head-to-head. Bowers maintains her strong lead after voters hear additional balanced messaging for both candidates.



With a robust campaign highlighting Bowers' accomplishments and agenda on education, health care, and racial justice, she is well-positioned for reelection this November.
